## **BBSC Minutes of Meeting**

*June 6, 2023*

The meeting was attended by 13 members and no guests.

Location of the meeting was the Masonic Lodge in Alpine. The meeting was called to order at 6:03pm by president Jim Westermann. Scott McClanahan gave the invocation - FDR's famous D-Day prayer, Pride of Our Nation.

The May 2nd minutes were read by Scott McClanahan. Kyp Angel motioned to accept and David Rohr seconded, the minutes were accepted.

Liz Measures read the treasurer's report. Expenses include spray paint for steel targets. There were 28 keys sold with a total of 456 paid memberships this year, 3 ahead of last year and 5 ahead of 2021. Doug Graham motioned to accept the treasurer's report and Sylvia Nelson seconded. The motion carried.

### *Old Business*

No shotgun or archery reports.

Camera system is still evolving.

Luke Hendrix is the AgriLife extension agent in the area and head of the 4H club. They have bolt action 22lr rifles somewhere and we would like to organize a shoot with the group.

The next discussion was about Packing Pretty and a run & gun woman only event on August 26. The event handles 50 competitors. The original venue was the Anchor Ranch, but there are insurance issues, which can cost \$5,000 to \$8,000 per day. Robin Harrison reported on this event, which is all day and uses all ranges. Doug Graham motioned to host the event at BBSC's range and Roger Amis seconded.

The rifle range conex protects the Pistol #1 and Rifle Range from each other. The berm is slowly collapsing behind it, but the decision was made to leave the dirt alone to help with protecting the two ranges.

### *New Business*

The Alpine Gun and Knife Show is Labor Day weekend, Saturday and Sunday, September 2nd and 3rd. Ronny Dobson's family has a wedding that Saturday, so various volunteers will watch his gun store's table in the afternoon. Nick Harrison will provide security and check firearms for the show. The Lion's raffle drawing is on Sunday when tickets are sold out or near the end of the show. There are two winners with the choice of a S&W FPC firearm or 1000 rounds of 9mm ammunition.

Sylvia Nelson motioned to adjourn at 6:32pm and Robert Johnson seconded.
