BBSC Minutes of Meeting

August 1, 2023

The meeting was attended by 19 members and one guest, Eliana Dykehouse of the Sul Ross Range and Wildlife Club.

Location of the meeting was the Masonic Lodge in Alpine. The meeting was called to order at 6:04pm by president Jim Westermann. Roger Amis gave the invocation.

Reports

The June 6th minutes were read by Scott McClanahan. Roger Amis motioned to accept and Michael McDaniel seconded, and the minutes were accepted.

Liz Measures read the treasurer's report. Expenses include tax preparation and the gun show table. There were 15 new members, 471 total for the year, compared to 484 last year. Motion by Michael McDaniel to accept, and seconded by Ralph Gruebel, and the motion carried.

Old Business

The shotgun report from Phil O'Shaughnessy and Monty Kimball was the need for another pallet of clay targets and the high house roof repaired. Jim Westermann is negotiating with True Value to acquire the pallet. Monty Kimball turned in \$350 from shooting rounds of skeet and trap (116 rounds, about 3,000 targets, 28% of a pallet). We are shooting shotgun sports Wednesday evenings and Sunday afternoons.

Ralph Gruebel reported the archery targets are back up, and the Cub Scout pack is interested in the range when the leaders get certified.

Camera system had problems with half the camera ports not working. Jim Westermann bought a new NVR and will install it when the weather gets cooler.

New Business

Sylvia Nelson reported on the Run & Gun (August 26). Steel targets were ordered. There is a meeting August 8th.

Eliana Dykehouse of the Sul Ross Range and Wildlife Club reported that setting the date is the strategic decision. We decided on October 14th, with set up the 13th at 4pm. Need to define rules for events.

Luke Hendrix has all of the 4H Club 22lr rifles. Need to get the 4H Club to the range.

Secretary needs to create flier of organized shoots for gun store counters.

Ralph Gruebel motioned to adjourn at 6:45pm and Robert Johnson seconded.
