July 2nd, 2024

The meeting was attended by 13 members and 1 guest, Mari Montemayor. Location of the meeting was the Masonic Lodge in Alpine. The meeting was called to order at 6:03pm by president Jim Westermann. John O Hollis gave the invocation.

Reports

New gate and clean up will occur tomorrow morning.

The July 3rd minutes were read by Scott McClanahan. Mike Boren motioned to accept and Pat Boren seconded, and the minutes were accepted.

Phil O'Shaughnessy gave the shotgun report. High house rewired for AC. Waiting on the bill. Next is a new roof and new doors.

No archery report this month.

Liz Measures read the treasurer's report. Expenses include dumpster, phone, power, BBSF banquet table, BBSF lever action rifle donation, and taxes. Need to match power bills to meter - two bills and one meter. Five new members, 451 paid members, 20 less than last year. Pat Boren motioned to accept, Mike Boren seconded, the report was accepted.

Old Business

The BBSF Banquet is Thursday, August 15th. Table of guns is Rost Martin 9mm.

ATF rules and Chevron Deference Supreme Court decision discussed.

David Wilson made donations to the BBSC through the Willard Lowell Hendershott Charitable Trust. \$3500 is for shotgun, \$2000 for pistol, and \$4000 for the banquet table of guns.

Pistol 1 and rifle closed July 9th for Armed Women of America.

Roger Amis pointed out the May 18th swap meet had no one show up. The May meeting had the discussion of ATF rules about definition of a dealer. There was also no notice sent to members.

New Business

Aaron Bonsell and Matt Covert asked for 4 Saturdays to run 3-Gun competition. There was much discussion about the dates, number of participants, and insurance. Turkey shoot discussed. Liz Measures will talk to Range and Wildlife Club sponsor about their election of officers.

Discussed prorating last 3 months of membership, but makes envelope labels and point of sale terminal more complicated.
