BBSC Minutes of Meeting September 3rd, 2024

The meeting was attended by 17 members and 3 guests, Matt Covert, Marie Graham, and John Lomas. Location of the meeting was the Masonic Lodge in Alpine. The meeting was called to order at 6:03pm by president Jim Westermann. John O Hollis gave the invocation.

Reports

The August 6th minutes were read by Scott McClanahan. John O Hollis motioned to accept and Ralph Gruebel seconded, the minutes were accepted.

Liz Measures read the treasurer's report. 459 paid members, the final count for the year. Most of the expenses for the year were paid. Keys were \$3000, membership printing \$550, insurance \$7366 (up 8%), lease \$4362, gun show table \$60. John O Hollis motioned to accept, and Roger Amis seconded and passed.

A motion was made to donate \$500 to the Masonic Lodge. Robert Johnson seconded, and the motion carried.

Monty Kimball reported shotgun has bought 2 pallets of clay targets. Debbie Shelton of the Alpine Christian School will organize weekly skeet shooting for students (age 10 to 16, expecting 12). They have a BBSF grant for ammo and pay \$5 for each round. Club members are needed as instructors. Parents need to sign a waiver. Will find out insurance by the school from their comptroller.

New Business

The nomination for officers had no response, so Patrick Hooker motioned that by proclamation, the current officers be elected as the 2024-2025 officers. Ralph Gruebel seconded, and the motion passed.

TSRA-PAC 2024 Voters' Guide

TSRA PAC VOTERS' GUIDE

Voters' Guides are provided to give information on Texas Senate and House Candidates' Second Amendment views. No other issues are considered in these ratings. REMEMBER: This is the ONLY source for accurate TSRA PAC voter guide information. If you get it from anywhere else, it MAY NOT BE authentic. If you are solicited or find any other source purporting to be TSRA PAC Voters' Guide information, please let us know right away.

Endorsed Candidates are listed in bold print.

A+ - A legislator with not only an excellent voting record on all critical issues, but who has also made a vigorous effort to promote and defend the Second Amendment.

A - Solidly pro-gun candidate. A candidate who has supported positions on key votes in elective office or a candidate with a demonstrated record of support on Second Amendment issues.

AQ - A pro-gun candidate whose rating is based solely on the candidate's responses to the Candidate Questionnaire and who does not have a voting record on Second Amendment issues.

B - A generally pro-gun candidate. However, a "B" candidate may have opposed some pro-gun reform or supported some restrictive legislation in the past.

C - Not necessarily a passing grade. A candidate with a mixed record or positions on gun related issues, who may oppose some pro-gun positions or support some restrictive legislation.

D - An anti-gun candidate who usually supports restrictive gun control legislation and opposes pro-gun reforms. Regardless of public statements, can usually be counted on to vote wrong on key issues.

F - True enemy of gun owners' rights. A consistent anti-gun candidate who always opposes gun owners' rights and/or actively leads anti-gun legislative efforts, or sponsors anti-gun legislation.

? - Refused to answer the candidate questionnaire or a candidate who has made contradictory statements or taken positions that are inconsistent with the candidate's answers to the candidate questionnaire or previous record. A rating of "?" often indicates indifference, if not outright hostility, to gun owners' and sportsmen's rights.
