BBSC Minutes of Meeting November 5th, 2024

The meeting was attended by 11 members and no guests. Location of the meeting was the Masonic Lodge in Alpine. The meeting was called to order at 6:05pm by president Jim Westermann.

Reports

The October 1st minutes were read by Scott McClanahan. James Webb motioned to accept and Roger Amis seconded, the minutes were accepted.

Liz Measures read the treasurer's report. 54 new members. 307 members total this year. There were \$3900 in expenses including \$500 for the Mason's scholarship, \$130 to renew web domain, clay targets, burritos at the Turkey Shoot, and some archery costs. Roger Amis motioned to accept, and Ralph Gruebel seconded, and the report was accepted.

Monty Kimball reported the HSCTL league finished and won their league. ACS is still shooting and now has 5 new TriStar 20 gauge semiautos with youth and adult stocks. The shotguns are stored at Phil O'Shaughnessy's house. The BBSF made donations to the ACS for the clay targets, ammunition, shotguns, and cleaning supplies. Phil O'Shaughnessy wants to do the shotgun range work.

No Turkey Shoot report. The leadership continuity in the Range and Wildlife Club hampers the effort. The BBSC should have a similar event in April.

Matt Colvert reported on the 3 gun event. The match broke even. The next match will be in the spring and include pistol caliber carbines and a senior division. Proposed dates for the next match are 3-22, 4-19, 5-10, 6-21, 7-19, and 9-20.

New Business

Ralph Gruebel requested a picnic table at the Archery pavilion. Monty Kimball motioned to study the costs, and Roger Amis seconded.

Old Business

The Porta Potty service is back after missing September and October.

Ralph Gruebel reported the Archery Range sign is up.

Roger Amis motioned to adjourn at 6:38pm and James Webb seconded.
