It's time to get yourselves ready for the 2025 Alpine 3-Gun Series! There will be many changes to the format and scoring this year, all of which are outlined below.

Firstly, to anyone who is interested in being a Range Officer, please click [here](#) and let me know so I can get you scheduled. Some competition experience is preferred. First come, first served.

For other competitors, the new website at Alpine3Gun.com is up and running. This is where you can read the rulebook, contact me with questions, and register for events. Registration is now open, and thank you to those who have already registered!

Major changes from last year:

- All six 2025 events will count toward a championship points series.
- There will be four Divisions (Open, Rookie, 50+, and Ladies) Everyone has a real shot at winning their division.
- Shooters can now choose to use a PCC instead of a rifle.

Prizes will be minimal, with the ultimate goal of donating as much money as possible to the Alpine Christian School shooting program, or the Big Bend Shooting Foundation, or the Big Bend Sportsman Club, or some combination thereof. Ultimately, the purpose of this 3-Gun series is to reinvest in our shooting community.

Alpine 3-Gun Quick Start Guide

What Is A 3-Gun Shooting Competition?

A 3-Gun is an event where shooters will compete against others with a pistol, rifle, and shotgun. At an Alpine 3 Gun event you'll be timed while shooting eight stages. The lowest cumulative time across all stages wins the match.

What Equipment Do I Need?

Don't worry too much about getting a lot of gear before coming to an event. Bring the pistol, rifle, and shotgun you already have - almost any weapon is eligible. See the Official Rulebook at Alpine3Gun.com for details.

Can Anyone Join?

Of course! New competitors are encouraged to join. The team of Range Officers has ample experience helping newer shooters get through each stage. You'll have nothing to worry about.

Who Am I Competing Against?

There are four divisions: **Open Division** for experienced shooters, **Rookie Division** for new and curious shooters, **50+ Division** for the salty vets with nothing to prove, and **Ladies Division** for a more civilized approach. You'll be competing with others at your level.

How Much Does It Cost?

Registration is \$75 per match. You can register for each individual match as it comes up. There will be six matches in 2025. Members of the Big Bend Sportsman Club can use the code **SPORTSMAN** at checkout to enjoy \$10 off registration.

What Will The Money Be Used For?

The ultimate goal of the 2025 Alpine 3-Gun series is to fund the Alpine Christian School shooting program, or donate to the Big Bend Shooting Foundation, or donate to the Big Bend Sportsman Club, or some combination thereof. Ultimately, a large portion of the funds collected from registration will be used to improve and expand our marksmanship community.
