## **BBSC Minutes of Meeting March 4th, 2025**

The meeting was attended by 14 members and 3 guests from the RWC. Location of the meeting was the Masonic Lodge in Alpine. The meeting was called to order at 6:00pm by president Jim Westermann. Invocation was by John O Hollis.

### Reports

The minutes of February 4th were read by Scott McClanahan. Donny Greenway motioned to accept and Roger Amis seconded.

Liz Measures read the treasurer's report. 8 new members. 421 members total this year. Motion to accept by John O Hollis, second by Roger Amis.

Phil O'Shaughnessy reported the donated trap machines are the same size as the three we've owned for decades. Shotgun range would like a container. The clay target source problem has been resolved. True Value is able to get pallets again.

### New Business

The Sul Ross RWC reported \$590 in expenses for the turkey shoot, and made \$570, so lost \$20. Nick Harrison motioned to donate \$500 to the RWC, and seconded by Donny Greenway.

The t-shirt and decal information posted on Facebook was criminal activity.

Scott McClanahan requested a bulletin board at the range - locked and behind glass - to post information sent in meeting notices. Robert Johnson motioned for \$500 to fund the bulletin board, and Scott McClanahan seconded.

We need a new source for the keys and locks at the range in August.

### Old Business

Discussion about 3 Gun competition taking over the range continued. The key element is how many BBSC members participate.

The old road equipment blades are in the county scrap pile. They are difficult to extract and weigh over 100#. The county wants all of the scrap bid on and removed.
